What Butterfly House Opening

Tyler Arboretum's Butterfly House offers visitors a unique opportunity to learn about, photograph and get a close-up look at local butterflies in all stages of development. The exhibit features a 1,400 square foot Butterfly House filled with natives including monarchs, sulphurs, hairstreaks, red-spotted purples, great spangled fritillaries, painted ladies and swallowtails. The exhibit includes extensive plantings that feed both butterflies and caterpillars.

The goal of Tyler's Butterfly House exhibit is to promote greater understanding about a significant aspect of ecology and human interaction with the natural world.

The Butterfly House exhibit is free with the price of regular admission and open seasonally through the months of July and August.
