



SUMMER CAMP MULTI-AGE COUNSELOR

Seasonal position. Reporting to the Age Group Coordinator

Position Summary

The Multi-Age Camp Counselor is responsible for planning, leading, and implementing adventure experiences for campers of a variety of ages. Middle school and high school programs include off-site field trips, and overnights. Multi-Age Counselor will deliver programs and experiences for children ages 5-10, 11-13 and 14-17, depending on the week.

Availability

Position is Seasonal. Multi-Age Counselors must be available Mondays 8:00am-4:15pm and Tuesday-Friday 8:15am-4:15pm, from June 17 thru August 16, 2019 (Except July 4-5). Multi-Age Counselors must also be available for overnights on July 10, 11, 18 & 25, August 1 & 8.

Compensation

\$12.00 - \$14.00/hour, commensurate with experience.

Duties/Responsibilities

- Share Tyler's rich heritage, collections and landscape to inspire and engage stewards of the natural world.
- Create a community environment to help youth gain a sense of belonging.
- Plan, organize and lead a variety of activities each week, including camping and wilderness skills.
- Lead Adventurer (high school) camps for two weeks, which includes day trips and off-site camping. Activities include biking, hiking, NJ boardwalk and the beach.
- Lead Naturalists (middle school) camps for four weeks, including an on-site overnight each week and day field trips. Activities include canoeing, tubing, biking and kayaking.
- Lead two Explorer (elementary school) camps for two weeks of the summer.
- Drive a mini-van on field trip outings.
- Follow all policies and procedures for maintaining supervision of campers at all times.
- Know and understand all emergency procedures associated with the camp program.
- Identify and respond positively to camper behavior issues.
- Set the "spirit" of camp by exhibiting passion about nature, camp and community.
- Report to work on time, dressed appropriately, and ready for camp.
- Complete other duties as assigned.

Essential Requirements

- Excellent character, integrity and adaptability
- Ability to teach and lead various recreational and environmental activities
- Ability to communicate and work with children ages 7-17
- The desire and ability to work in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere
- Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control

- Willing and able to participate in all camp activities with campers, which includes, but are not limited to, hiking, camping, biking, swimming, tubing, kayaking, canoeing, team building initiatives, physical games and activities
- Availability and ability to lead off-site and on-site overnights with a group of campers
- First aid and CPR certification, or willingness to be certified
- Must be at least 25 years of age with a clean driving record
- Satisfactory completion of the required background checks including PA child abuse clearances.

(Note: Tyler has the right to assign or reassign duties and responsibilities to this job at any time.)

Work Environment

- General work on the Arboretum's grounds.
- Requires frequent and prolonged standing, walking, bending, kneeling, pulling, twisting and climbing.
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds and carry a 30 pound pack on steep terrain.
- Ability to work and sleep outdoors in all weather conditions.

Tyler Arboretum, a public garden in the Philadelphia suburbs, covers 650 acres of renowned plant collections, champion trees, and historic buildings, with 17 miles of hiking trails through woodlands, wetlands, and meadows. Tyler offers workshops, classes, and tours for adults and children throughout the year.
